An act to amend Section 4581 of the Public Resources Code, relating to timber harvesting.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1977, as introduced, Bradford. Timber harvesting plans.

The Z'berg-Nejedly Forest Practice Act of 1973 prohibits a person from conducting timber operations unless a timber harvesting plan prepared by a registered professional forester has been submitted to the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 4581 of the Public Resources Code is

5 forester has been submitted for ~~such~~ *those* operations to the
6 department pursuant to this article. ~~Such~~ *The* plan shall be required
7 in addition to the license required in Section 4571.

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
