An act to amend Section 811.2 of the Government Code, relating to the Tort Claims Act.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2524, as introduced, Harkey. Tort Claims Act: public entities.

The Tort Claims Act provides for the liability and immunity of a governmental entity for its acts or omissions that cause harm to persons, and defines a public entity for these purposes.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to these provisions.
