Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 88—Relative to Arthritis Awareness Month.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SCR 88, as amended, Alquist. Arthritis Awareness Month.

This measure would proclaim the month of May 2012 as Arthritis Awareness Month.

Fiscal committee: no.

1 WHEREAS, Arthritis includes more than 100 rheumatic diseases
2 and conditions that affect joints, the tissues that surround joints,
3 and other connective tissue; and
4 WHEREAS, Arthritis causes ~~pain~~, *pain and* loss of movement,
5 and can limit everyday activities such as walking and dressing;
6 and
7 WHEREAS, Arthritis affects an estimated 50 million adults
8 living with some form of doctor-diagnosed arthritis, rheumatoid
9 arthritis, gout, lupus, or fibromyalgia, representing approximately
10 1 in 5 adults in the United States; and
11 WHEREAS, An estimated 294,000 children under 18 years of
12 age have some form of arthritis or rheumatic condition,
13 representing approximately 1 in every 250 children in the United
14 States; and

1 WHEREAS, Arthritis is a chronic health problem and the
2 nation's leading cause of physical disability among Americans
3 over 15 years of age; and

4 WHEREAS, Arthritis costs the United States economy more
5 than \$128 billion each year in lost wages and health care costs;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, Arthritis results in 992,100 hospitalizations and
8 44 million outpatient visits each year; and

9 WHEREAS, In California there are 5.1 million people living
10 with arthritis, including 38,000 children; and

11 WHEREAS, An estimated 67 million adults 18 years of age and
12 older, representing 25 percent of the population of the United
13 States, will have doctor-diagnosed arthritis by the year 2030; now,
14 therefore, be it

15 *Resolved by the Senate of the State of California, the Assembly*
16 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature understands the extent
17 of, and sympathizes with, the severity of the impact of arthritis on
18 California; and be it further

19 *Resolved*, That the Legislature recognizes the month of May
20 2012 as Arthritis Awareness Month and appreciates the efforts of
21 the California Arthritis Foundation Council to seek access to care
22 for all Californians; and be it further

23 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Senate transmit copies of
24 this resolution to the author for appropriate distribution.
