An act to amend Section 16018 of the Education Code, relating to school facilities.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1104, as introduced, Emmerson. School facilities: offsite facilities.

Existing law requires that apportionments from the State School Building Aid Fund to school districts, subject to specified conditions, be used for specified purposes, including, among other things, the purchase and improvement of schoolsites which have been approved by the State Department of Education. Existing law authorizes these apportionments to also be used for the construction, repair, attachment or development of offsite facilities, utilities or improvements if the State Allocation Board determines they are necessary to the proper operation or functioning of the school facilities for which apportionments are made.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to the latter provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
