An act to amend Section 13100 of the Government Code, relating to infrastructure.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2134, as introduced, Mansoor. Infrastructure.

Existing law requires the Governor to submit to the Legislature, in conjunction with his or her annual budget proposal, a proposed 5-year infrastructure plan that identifies state infrastructure needs and sets out priorities for funding. Existing law requires the plan to be sufficiently detailed to provide a clear understanding of the type and amount of infrastructure to be funded and the programmatic objectives to be achieved by this funding approach.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to this provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13100 of the Government Code is
2 amended to read:
3 13100. It is the intent of the Legislature in enacting this article
4 that the state shall establish and annually update a five-year plan
5 for funding infrastructure. The plan shall include input by the
6 Legislature as provided in Section 13104. The plan shall identify
7 state infrastructure needs and set out priorities for funding. The

1 plan need not identify specific infrastructure projects to be funded,
2 but it shall be sufficiently detailed to provide a clear understanding
3 of the type and amount of infrastructure to be funded and the
4 programmatic objectives to be achieved by this funding. The plan
5 is intended to complement the existing state budget process for
6 appropriating funds for infrastructure by providing a
7 comprehensive guideline for the types of projects to be funded
8 through that process.
