An act to add Section 2602 to the Penal Code, relating to prisoners.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 369, as amended, Havice. Prisoners: rights.

Existing law specifies the terms and conditions of imprisonment for persons sentenced to the state prison.

This bill would provide that a person sentenced to imprisonment in the state prison *for a violent felony, as specified*, does not have a right to, and shall not be allowed, conjugal visits, ~~and does not have a right to, and shall not be allowed, to watch television.~~

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
