ASSEMBLY BILL

An act to amend Section 1653.5 of, and to add Section 12802.6 to, the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2574, as amended, Briggs. Vehicles: driver's license: selective service registration.

Existing law requires every applicant for an original or a renewal of, a driver's license to provide appropriate information concerning identification, personal history, health, knowledge of traffic signs and signals, and the type of motor vehicle the applicant desires to operate. Existing federal law, the Military Selective Service Act, requires certain males residing in the United States to register in accordance to rules and regulations adopted in accordance with federal law. Existing law also requires all state agencies to cooperate with the United States Selective Service System to publicize the necessity of, and the requirements for compliance with the federal act.

This bill would require the Department of Motor Vehicles, for every ~~male~~ applicant between 18 and 26 years of age, inclusive, with certain exceptions, for an original or a renewal

of, a driver’s license to provide the applicant, at the time of application, with notification that the applicant is or will be required to be in compliance with the federal act and that if the applicant is not already registered with the federal Selective Service System, ~~he will be registered automatically as a result of submitting the application to the department~~ *the applicant may register with the service by checking an appropriate box on the application.* The bill would also require the department, *if federal financial support is provided, and in cooperation with the federal selective service system,* to develop the notification form and applicable implementation procedures.

The bill would make other, conforming changes in existing law.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1653.5 of the Vehicle Code is
 2 amended to read:
 3 1653.5. (a) Every form prescribed by the
 4 department for use by an applicant for the issuance or
 5 renewal by the department of a driver’s license or
 6 identification card pursuant to Division 6 (commencing
 7 with Section 12500) shall contain a section for the
 8 applicant’s social security account number.
 9 (b) Every form prescribed by the department for use
 10 by an applicant for the issuance, renewal, or transfer of
 11 the registration or certificate of title to a vehicle shall
 12 contain a section for the applicant’s driver’s license or
 13 identification card number.
 14 (c) Any person who submits to the department a form
 15 that, pursuant to subdivision (a), contains a section for the
 16 applicant’s social security account number, or pursuant to
 17 subdivision (b), the applicant’s driver’s license or
 18 identification card number, if any, shall furnish the
 19 appropriate number in the space provided.
 20 (d) The department shall not complete any
 21 application that does not include the applicant’s social

2 identification card number as required by subdivision
3 (c).

4 (e) An applicant's social security account number shall
5 not be included by the department on any driver's
6 license, identification card, registration, certificate of
7 title, or any other document issued by the department.

8 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
9 information regarding an applicant's social security
10 account number, obtained by the department pursuant
11 to this section, is not a public record and shall not be
12 disclosed by the department except for any of the
13 following purposes:

14 (1) Responding to a request for information from an
15 agency operating pursuant to, and carrying out the
16 provisions of, Part A (Aid to Families with Dependent
17 Children), or Part D (Child Support and Establishment
18 of Paternity), of Subchapter IV of Chapter 7 of Title 42 of
19 the United States Code.

20 (2) Implementation of Section 12419.10 of the
21 Government Code.

22 (3) Responding to information requests from the
23 Franchise Tax Board for the purpose of tax
24 administration.

25 (4) Registration with the federal Selective Service
26 System in compliance with the Military Selective Service
27 Act (50 U.S.C. Sec. 451 and following).

28 SEC. 2. Section 12802.6 is added to the Vehicle Code,
29 to read:

30 12802.6. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of
31 law, for every applicant for an original or a renewal of a
32 driver's license who is ~~male and~~ 18 to 26 years of age,
33 inclusive, the department shall provide the applicant, at
34 the time of application, with notification of both of the
35 following:

36 (1) That the applicant is or will be required to be in
37 compliance with the federal Military Selective Service
38 Act (50 U.S.C. Sec. 451 and following).

39 (2) That if the applicant is not already registered with
40 the federal Selective Service System, ~~he will be registered~~

5 (b) ~~The~~ *If federal financial support is provided, the*
6 *department, in cooperation with the federal Selective*
7 *Service System, shall develop forms and procedures for*
8 *the implementation of subdivision (a).*

9 (c) Subdivision (a) is not applicable to a person who
10 is exempt from the Military Selective Service Act for any
11 reason.
