An act to amend Section 1653.5 of, and to add Section ~~12802.6~~ 1678 to, the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2574, as amended, Briggs. Vehicles: driver's license: selective service registration.

Existing law requires every applicant for an original or a renewal of, a driver's license to provide appropriate information concerning identification, personal history, health, knowledge of traffic signs and signals, and the type of motor vehicle the applicant desires to operate. Existing federal law, the Military Selective Service Act, requires certain males residing in the United States to register in accordance to rules and regulations adopted in accordance with federal law. Existing law also requires all state agencies to cooperate with the United States Selective Service System to publicize the necessity of, and the requirements for compliance with the federal act.

This bill would require the Department of Motor Vehicles, for every applicant between 18 and 26 25 years of age, inclusive, with certain exceptions, for an original or a renewal of, a driver’s license *or identification card* to provide the applicant, at the time of application, with notification that ~~the applicant is~~ *males 18 to 25 years of age, inclusive, are* or will be required to be in compliance with the federal act and that if the applicant is *male and is* not already registered with the federal Selective Service System, the applicant may register with the service by checking an appropriate box on the application. The bill would also require the department, if federal financial support is provided, and in cooperation with the federal selective service system, to develop the notification form and applicable implementation procedures.

The bill would make other, conforming changes in existing law.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 3 1653.5. (a) Every form prescribed by the
- 4 department for use by an applicant for the issuance or
- 5 renewal by the department of a driver’s license or
- 6 identification card pursuant to Division 6 (commencing
- 7 with Section 12500) shall contain a section for the
- 8 applicant’s social security account number.
- 9 (b) Every form prescribed by the department for use
- 10 by an applicant for the issuance, renewal, or transfer of
- 11 the registration or certificate of title to a vehicle shall
- 12 contain a section for the applicant’s driver’s license or
- 13 identification card number.
- 14 (c) Any person who submits to the department a form
- 15 that, pursuant to subdivision (a), contains a section for the
- 16 applicant’s social security account number, or pursuant to
- 17 subdivision (b), the applicant’s driver’s license or
- 18 identification card number, if any, shall furnish the
- 19 appropriate number in the space provided.



1 (d) The department shall not complete any  
2 application that does not include the applicant's social  
3 security account number or driver's license or  
4 identification card number as required by subdivision  
5 (c).

6 (e) An applicant's social security account number shall  
7 not be included by the department on any driver's  
8 license, identification card, registration, certificate of  
9 title, or any other document issued by the department.

10 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,  
11 information regarding an applicant's social security  
12 account number, obtained by the department pursuant  
13 to this section, is not a public record and shall not be  
14 disclosed by the department except for any of the  
15 following purposes:

18 provisions of, Part A (Aid to Families with Dependent  
19 Children), or Part D (Child Support and Establishment  
20 of Paternity), of Subchapter IV of Chapter 7 of Title 42 of

24 (3) Responding to information requests from the  
25 Franchise Tax Board for the purpose of tax  
26 administration.

27 (4) Registration with the federal Selective Service  
28 System in compliance with the Military Selective Service  
29 Act (50 U.S.C. Sec. 451 and following).

33 1678. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of  
34 law, for every applicant for an original or a renewal of a  
35 ~~driver's license who is 18 to 26 years of age, driver's license~~  
36 *or identification card who is 18 to 25 years of age,*  
37 inclusive, the department shall provide the applicant, at  
38 the time of application, with notification of both of the  
39 following:

40 ~~(1) That the applicant is or will be required to be in~~



1 (1) That males 18 to 25 years of age, inclusive, are or  
2 will be required to be in compliance with the federal  
3 Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C. Sec. 451 and  
4 following).

5 (2) That if the applicant is *male and is* not already  
6 registered with the federal Selective Service System, the  
7 applicant may register with the service by checking an  
8 appropriate box on the application.

9 (b) If federal financial support is provided, the  
10 department, in cooperation with the federal Selective  
11 Service System, shall develop forms and procedures for  
12 the implementation of subdivision (a).

13 (c) Subdivision (a) is not applicable to a person who  
14 is exempt from the Military Selective Service Act for any  
15 reason.
